What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files sent from a website and stored in the user's web browser while the user is browsing a website.

Our website should be fully functional, even if your browser is set to not accept any cookies.

When you use the MMIT website the following types of cookies could be set on your device:

Strictly Necessary cookies

Strictly necessary cookies enable you to move around sites and use their features and/or services. Without these absolutely necessary cookies, websites may not perform as smoothly as they should and may not be able to provide certain services or features.

Performance cookies

Performance cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.

Functional cookies

Functional cookies allow websites to remember choices you make and any customisations you make during your visit and provide enhanced, more personal features. For instance, these cookies can be used to remember changes you have made to text size, fonts and other parts of web pages that you can customise. They may also be used to provide services you have asked for such as watching a video or commenting on a blog.

Targeting and advertising cookies

Targeting or Advertising cookies are linked to services provided by third parties. The third party provides these services in return for recognising that you have visited a website. These cookies collect information about your browsing habits on a website in order to make advertising both on the website and other websites you subsequently visit relevant to you and your interests, to limit the number of times those adverts are served to you and to help measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

Other third party cookies

Some cookies that are set on a website are not related to the site itself. When you visit a page with content embedded from, for example, YouTube or Facebook, these service providers may set their own cookies in your web browser.

Managing cookies in your browser

You may refuse or accept cookies from this website at any time by activating settings in your browser.
